The Great Fire of London is one of the most well-known disasters in London's history. It began on 2 September 1666. One-third of London was destroyed and about 100,000 people were made homeless.

The fire started at 1 a.m. on Sunday morning in a bakery on Pudding Lane. It was probably caused by a spark from the oven. The fire spread easily because London was very dry after a long, hot summer. **5.1.** \_\_\_\_ The area around Pudding Lane was full of things like

wood, rope and oil. A very strong wind blew the fire from house to house in the narrow streets.

At the time, people didn't know about the dangers of fire. Buildings were made of wood and were tightly packed together. **5.2.** \_\_\_\_ This meant that the higher parts of the buildings reached the neighbours' houses, and fire could easily spread from building to building.

There was no fire brigade in London then so Londoners had to fight the fire themselves. The best way to stop the fire was to pull down houses to make gaps or 'fire breaks'. A quick way of demolishing houses was to blow them up with gunpowder. **5.3.**Finally, on Tuesday night the wind became less strong. By Thursday morning the fire was out

After the Great Fire new regulations were designed to prevent such a disaster from happening again. **5.4.** \_\_\_\_ Some streets were made wider and two new streets were built. The results were easy to see.
